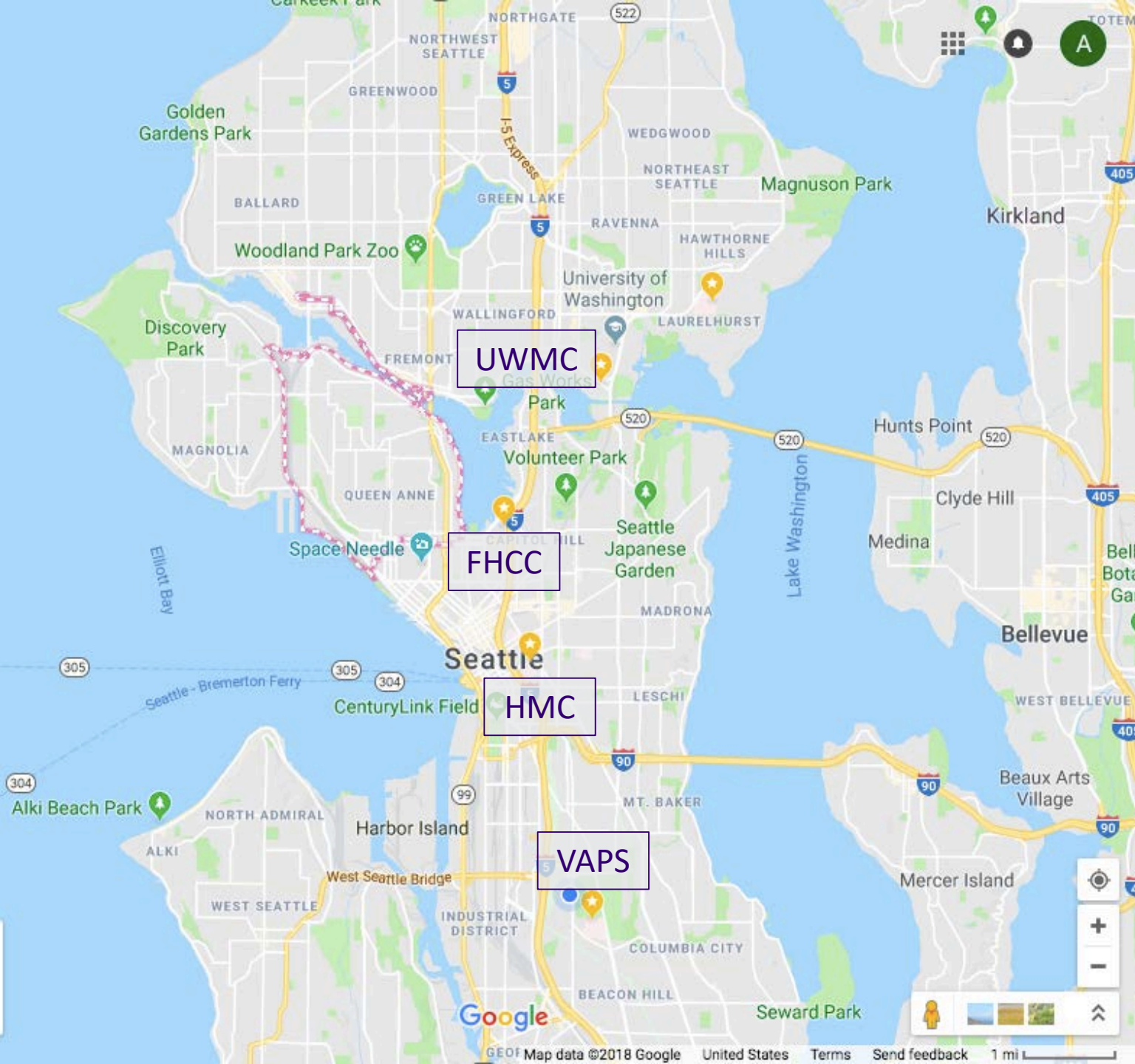

Salary and Benefits

- Salary of \$61,872 (\$5,156 per month)
- 21 days of vacation time off (15 weekdays, 6 weekend days)
- 1 paid personal holiday
- Sick time (accrued, 8 hours/month)
- ExpertPath & PathPrimer Accounts
- \$500 (pre-tax) Professional Development Stipend
 - One-time payment
- \$1,600 Travel Fund for traveling to conferences to present or take part in advocacy work
 - You pay upfront and submit receipts for reimbursement

Eligibility

Eligible applicants are UW medical students in current good standing who have taken and passed USMLE Step 1 prior to starting the fellowship. Preferred candidates are interested in pursuing Pathology studies, research, and clinical practices.

- Applicants are encouraged to discuss the details of this status with the registrar, and the financial aid department, and Brenda Martinez, the Director of Proactive Advising (somproadv@uw.edu, 206.543.9345).
- Medical students who participate in the program are considered “on leave” with the University of Washington School of Medicine; all loans are deferred during the program, and there is no tuition or financial aid penalty.

Application Deadline: November 15th

- Your application is considered complete once your [online form](#) in Embark is filled out and the following materials uploaded:
 - CV
 - Personal Statement (1-2 pages)
 - Letter of Recommendation (applicant to register letter writer through Embark)
 - Your letter writer should be someone who can speak to your clinical interests and experience. Often this is your medical school advisor, a faculty member you've worked closely with or a faculty member you've rotated with.
- Letter of Good Standing (e-mailed directly from the UW SOM registrar's office to uwpthres@uw.edu)
