ROTATIONS

Consult fellow at UWMC (3 months per fellow):

- Previews and signs out consults/slide reviews for assigned service at UWMC (see separate conference document) and portion of NW GYN and Breast oncology cases and Breast/gyn and BST consults.
- Cover chest tumor board and as interest/opportunity allows endocrine tumor board.
- Cover AM frozen sections 1 day/week
- Occasional supervising SP1 in gross room, particularly when there is shortage of PAs and/or no surg path mentor.
- Cover junior resident absences (for signout/frozens) during certain parts of the year.

HMC (2 months per fellows):

- See HMC schedule for further details approximately:
- 4 weeks as GU Fellow.
- Preview and signout GU consults/slide reviews.
- Teach AP-1 grossing/preview (entire month).
- Frozen coverage 8 am -5 pm approximately 2-3 frozen pages per week.
- 2 weeks neuropath.
- 2 weeks cytopath.
- Ongoing cyto exposure is encouraged while on GU consults.
- Present at conferences, tumor boards.

Elective (UW) (6 weeks):

- Cover AM frozens 1 day/week.
- Prepare bluebox (second 6 months)
- Duties of elective (goals and objectives and elective arranged prior to elective month)
- Occasionally cover sick leave for residents on surgpath without grossing. (depending on elective)

Surgical pathology mentor (UW) (8 weeks):

- Supervise junior residents (particularly AP1s, see detail below).
- Cover AM frozens 1 day/week.
- Backup PGY-1 on night/weekend call.
- Cover sick leave for residents on surgpath (as above).
- Prepare for and run bluebox (see below) first 6 months

Surgical and subspecialty coverage (UW), 13 weeks (approximately)

- 4 weeks (approximately) on general surgical service at UWMC including call
- 2-3 weeks Derm
- 2 3 weeks breastRotate through various subspecialties as the subspecialty fellow (e.g. 2 weeks breast/gyn, 2 weeks bone and soft tissue, 1 2 weeks GI).

AM Frozens:

Monday – GI Tuesday – SPF (acting director/elective) Wednesday – Breast/Gyn Thursday – Bone and Soft Tissue Friday – SPF (consult fellow)
