





Resident Benefits

- Insurance & Leave
- Trainees are unionized and part of the Resident & Fellow Physician Union - Northwest (RFPU)
- Health, Dental & Life insurance coverage including options long-term disability insurance
- Retirement plans with employer contribution and additional Voluntary Investment Program (VIP)
- 4 Weeks of vacation
- Up to 12 weeks of paid family or medical leave through the Washington Employment Security Department (ESD)

- 17 sick days a year (12 weekdays, 5 weekend days),
 accumulates year to year
- 10 paid observed holidays
- 1 paid personal holiday
- 2 unpaid personal holidays for reasons of faith or conscious
- 5 days guaranteed professional leave, with up to 5
 additional days granted at the discretion of the Program

Resident Benefits

- Stipends and Reimbursements
- \$1,600/year travel fund
- \$400/year Professional Development stipend
- Home Call Stipend of \$2400 paid as a lump sum in the first month of each academic year
- Full Reimbursement of required certifications (USMLE, COMLEX, WA State License)
- Expertpath & PathPrimer subscription paid by the department

- Meal reimbursement: Residents working in-house for 12 hours or longer receive reimbursement for the coast of 1 meal
- Transportation Stipend of \$100 paid as a lump sum in the first month of each academic year
- Full Subsidized UPass
- Trainees qualify to participate in the Public Service Loan
 Forgiveness (PSLF) program
